

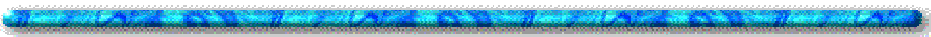


**FUNDING UPDATE FROM

“Funded” Youth For 2006 (as of 6/12/06)

☆ Habayita (hurricane affected) Jewish youth with camp scholarship aid	215

☆ Regular, needs-based, camp scholarship awards to youth from region not affected by 2005 hurricanes	281
☆ College aid awards, spring 2006 (A)	119
☆ Of 71 fall 2006 college aid awards made to date, the number of new first-time awards made to date (A)	19
☆ Special Needs youth funded/funding imminent for 2006	42
☆ Children provided gift cards for ongoing needs who are not already counted in another JCRS scholarship program (B)	8

- (A) Pre-Katrina college aid awards had been averaging **130** per academic year/**165** per calendar year. In view of effects of Hurricane Katrina, and other pending awards not yet approved by the college aid committee, JCRS expects to add an additional **25-50** college aid awards to calendar year 2006 totals by December 31, 2006.
- (B) To avoid duplication in total client counts, youth are only counted once on this chart. For example, there are approximately **50** youth, to date, who have already received funding in more than one 2006 program through June 12. In 2005, **300** low-income Jewish youth received Hanukkah gifts and approximately half were not funded or counted in other JCRS scholarship programs that year.
- (C) Please note, 2006 Hanukkah gift recipients are not yet counted on this chart, nor are contacts with approximately **100** former students who are repaying loans.
